

# All you need to know about Kwanzaa

It is common knowledge that Kwanzaa is observed from December 26<sup>th</sup> through January 1<sup>st</sup>, yet many Americans do not fully comprehend what this week-long holiday commemorates. Observing Kwanzaa is a way for Black Americans to reflect on an aspect of their heritage and community and to connect with one another and their African roots. Kwanzaa celebrations are not limited to black individuals, individuals from all backgrounds can celebrate this holiday.
