The **Atlantic slave trade** or **transatlantic slave trade** involved the transportation by slave traders of enslaved African people, mainly to the Americas (North and South America). It is estimated that between ten and twelve million Africans were transported from the continent of Africa to the Americas during the slave trade which occurred from the 16th century through the 19 century. The vast majority of those who were enslaved and transported in the transatlantic slave trade were people from Central and West Africa. This bibliography contains citations for a number of reference materials on the slave trade that are a part of the Auburn Avenue Research Library Reference collection. Although this is not a comprehensive list of all available resources at the Auburn Library, the resources cited will provide great insight on the history of the slave trade.

Resources include call numbers, for patrons to easily inquire and obtain resources. Auburn Avenue Research Library maintains non-circulating policies of its collection; however, patrons are able to utilize materials in-house. Suggested search terms and keywords are provided to further guide patron's research amongst Auburn Avenue Research Library and the Atlanta-Fulton Public Library catalog and digital libraries.
