

## REMEMBERING HARRY BELAFONTE



**Harry Belafonte** (born **Harold George Belafonte Jr.**; March 1, 1927 – April 25, 2023) was an American singer, actor and activist, who popularized calypso music with international audiences in the 1950s. Belafonte is one of the few performers to have received an Emmy, Grammy, Oscar, and Tony (EGOT), although he won the Oscar in a non-competitive category. In addition to his work as an entertainer, he was a very involved activist in the Civil Rights Movement and participated in the March on Washington (August 28, 1963). The Auburn Avenue Research Library of African American Culture and History celebrates the life and contributions of this icon. Users are invited and encouraged to explore the legacy of Harry Belafonte through the books and materials referenced in this bibliography.

Resources include call numbers, for patrons to easily inquire and obtain resources. Auburn Avenue Research Library maintains non-circulating policies of its collection; however, patrons are able to utilize materials in-house.
